VALUE OF A TENTH CHART

The chart above is intended to be used a guide to demonstrate dynamics of a spread or range in scoring. This information may assist you in management of ranking and rating, especially in larger events.

Toss Up:

The ensembles are essentially “equal” except for a few minor issues that caused you to make a decision one way or another.

Slight Advantage:

There are a least one or two distinct differences that make it clear that one ensemble is stronger than the other in performance or design (depending on the caption or sub caption you are using).

Strong Advantage:

There are some obvious differences in the performance and composition qualities of the two ensembles, which lead you to a confident advantage for one ensemble.

Decision:

There is a distinct and decisive difference between the two ensembles.
